Step by Step Acrylic Paint Class with Melissa

Beginning Quilting

With the use of a rotary cutter, mat, and straight edge ruler you will create a baby size blanket by cutting strips from fat quarters using the strip tango quilt pattern. Once pieced together you will join together the top, batting and backing and finish by tying the layers together. **Tools to bring to class:** Sewing machine in working order, scissors, tape measure, seam ripper, machine needles, rotary cutter, rotary cutter mat, rotary cutter straight edge ruler. **Supply list to bring to class:** 9 coordinating fat quarter packet squares (18" X 22" each), 45" X 60" quilt batting, 1 ¾ yards of 45" wide 100% cotton backing fabric (44" X 63"), and coordinating 100% cotton thread.

Beginning Sewing

Are you interested in learning the basics of sewing? Let me get you started on the right path to being a new seamstress. You will learn the parts of the sewing machine, the different sewing tools and how they are used and different sewing terms. You will practice sewing basic stitches and finishing stitches. You will learn to cut out a pattern and complete a simple pillow case or a simple seasonal table runner, your choice.

Supplies to bring to class: sewing machine in working order, scissors, seam ripper, tape measure, and pins.

Pillow case supplies: 45" wide 100% cotton or flannel fabric, .875 yard for the body, .25 for the band, 3" for piping, and matching thread.

Table runner supplies: 45" wide 100% cotton fabric, .625 yard for backing and front border, .334 yard for center strip, matching thread, and 2 coordinating buttons.
