Advanced Beginning Knitting: Cables

Learn the principles of knitting cables, how to read basic cable instructions, and practice 2 cable pattern stitches. Participants must be competent in basic knitting skills and must complete homework prior to class. Homework instructions will be provided when you register. Homework will involve casting on and completing several rows to set up the stitch patterns.

Beginning Quilting

Learn how to use a rotary cutter, a ruler and sewing machine. We will cut strips and piece together to create a small baby blanket using either the Rail Fence design or another option available upon registration. Finish size is 36"x36". **Supplies to bring:** sewing machine in working order, scissors, tape measure, seam ripper, rotary cutter, straight edge ruler (at least 24" long), rotary mat if you have one (I have extras), fabrics of your choice: 3 different coordinating fabrics in either cotton or flannel for front of quilt 45" wide .667 yd each—one should be a solid color, 1.25 yds of one of the three choices for the backing, 1.25 yds of 45" wide polyester batting, matching thread, matching pearl cotton floss or thin yarn to tie the quilt together. Please prewash and dry your fabric.

Very Beginning Sewing - Choose: Pillow Case or Table Runner

Come learn the very simple basics of sewing. You will learn different sewing terms, tools, sewing machine stitches, fabric choices and cutting techniques. You will cut out and sew together a simple pillow case or table runner. **Supplies to bring to class for the Pillow Case:** sewing machine in working order, scissors, tape measure, straight pins, seam ripper.

Cotton or Flannel fabric: .875 yard of main fabric for body of pillow case, .25 yard of contrast fabric for band of pillow case, 3" for piping on pillow case, matching thread. Please prewash and dry the fabric. **Supplies to bring to class for the Table Runner:** sewing machine in working order, scissors, tape measure, straight pins, seam ripper. Rotary cutter, mat and ruler optional. 100% Cotton fabric .625 yard of main fabric, .33 yard of contrast fabric (center), 3" for piping on table runner, matching thread and 2 fun coordinating buttons. Please prewash and dry the fabric.
