## **Beginning Crocheting 101**

Come learn the very basics of crocheting right handed. We will learn and practice how to hold the hook, hold the yarn, and work with tension. You will also learn and practice how to chain stitch, single crochet, and double crochet.

**Supplies to bring:** 100% cotton yarn (Sugar and Cream brand is a good choice), and a Size F crochet hook.

## **Beginning Sewing**

Are you interested in learning the basics of sewing? Let me get you started on the right path to being a new seamstress. You will learn the parts of the sewing machine, various sewing tools and how they are used and sewing terms. You will practice sewing basic stitches. **Supplies to bring to class:** sewing machine in working order, scissors, seam ripper, tape measure, and large glass head straight pins.

**Apron supplies:** Simplicity pattern #1221 (we can share mine if necessary), 45" wide cotton fabric- 1 ½ yards, 2 packages ½" wide double fold bias tape, thread.

**P.J. Bottoms supplies:** Simplicity pattern #8022 (we can share mine if necessary), 45" wide cotton or flannel fabric- depending on size you make, 2 yards or 2 ½ yards, elastic 1" wide – 1 ¾ yard, thread

**Fleece Dog Coat supplies:** Simplicity pattern #8277 (we can share mine if necessary), View C-60" wide fleece, depending on size of dog 5/8 yard to 7/8 yard main fabric, 3/8 yard for contrast, one ¾" button, 2 toggle closures, thread.

**Hobo Bag supplies:** Pattern supplied by instructor, 45" wide cotton fabric, one yard each of 2 different contrasting fabrics, thread.

**1 Hour Table Runner supplies:** Pattern supplied by instructor, 45" wide cotton fabric, 12" of printed theme fabric (not a one way design, use an all over design)- this will be the center front, 18" of coordinating print-this will be the edging and back, two 1" decorative buttons, thread.

## Saturday Quilting Day

With the use of a rotary cutter, mat, and straight edge ruler you will learn to make a simple quilt project from start to finish in one day. **Supplies to bring:** Sewing machine in working order, rotary cutter, rotary mat (I have extra if you do not want to purchase before you know if you will enjoy using it) straight edge rotary ruler 24" or longer (this is a must), long glass head or quilting straight pins, seam ripper, scissors, hand sewing needles, thread.

**Rail Fence Baby Quilt 23"X36" supplies:** 3 different coordinating 45" cotton or flannel fabric, ¾ yard of each: 1 piece solid, 2 pieces different printed pieces, (pre-wash/dry and press fabric before class), 1 ¼ yard fabric for backing, 1 ¼ yard polyester batting, thread, pearl cotton floss to tie finished quilt.

**Table Runner 22"X60" supplies:** 1/3 yard light print, ½ yard dark print, 1/3 yard solid color (pre-wash/dry and press fabric before class), 1 ¾ yard fabric for backing, 1 ¾ yard batting, thread, 9 ½-3/4" decorative buttons to hold table runner together.

**4 Patch Heart Design Baby Quilt 36"X36" supplies:** solid 1 ½ yards solid white cotton fabric, ¼ yard of 6-8 coordinating cotton prints- all pink OR all blue OR all variegated- your choice (pre-wash/dry and press fabric before class), 1 ¼ yard fabric for backing, white thread, matching pearl cotton floss to tie finished quilt.
