You will learn to cut out a pattern and complete a simple seasonal table runner. **Supplies to bring to class:** sewing machine in working order, scissors, seam ripper, tape measure, and pins, 45" wide 100% cotton fabric, .625 yard for backing and front border, .334 yard for center strip, matching thread, and 2 coordinating buttons.
