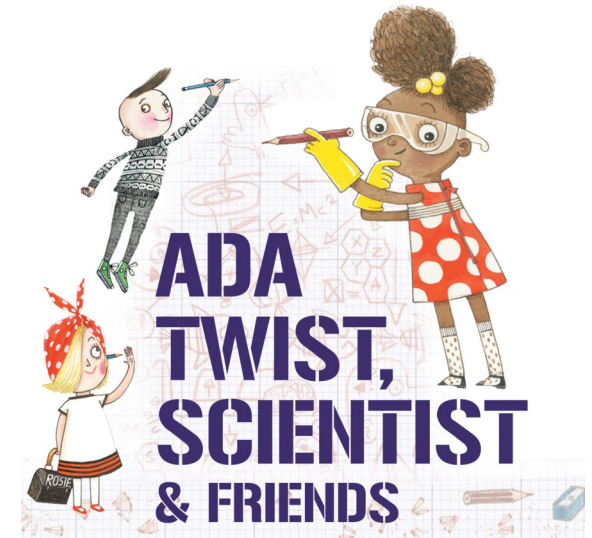
The Heider Center for the Arts is pleased to offer two wonderful performances to our area schools that are not only entertaining, but also educational as well.

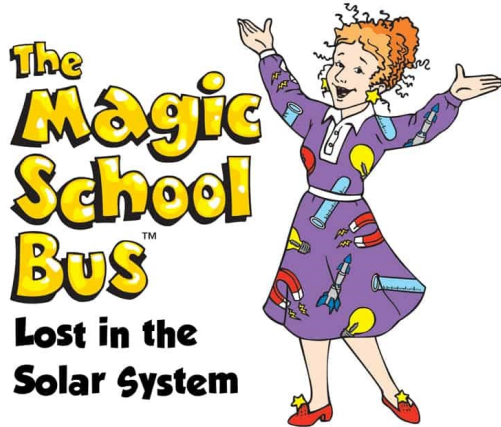
